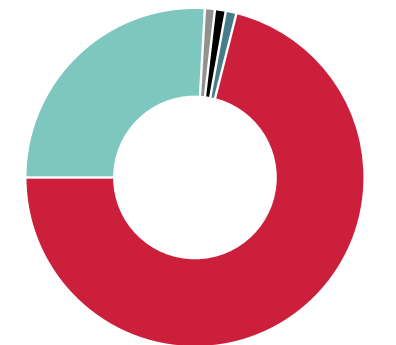


Location of 2019 Grads Now
